Introducing Braver Angels



We are excited to announce a new initiative at St. Peter's and want to invite all members to join us. St. Peter's will be hosting two events led by Braver Angels in February and April, and they will help us to focus on common ground despite our differing perspectives and viewpoints.



Braver Angels is a national organization with a local presence here in Central Pennsylvania, which is dedicated to "bringing Americans together to bridge the partisan divide and strengthen our democratic republic." Braver Angels has a specific program for faith communities, where they bring depolarizing skills and experiences to congregations and faith-based organizations.

As a congregation of almost 1,000 members, we vary in our ages, viewpoints, and life experiences. Yet we share a belief in a gracious and loving God and we all strive to follow Jesus in this world. We believe that we can strengthen our congregation and our ministry together by better listening to one another and learning from each other. Braver Angels are experts in helping people and congregations do this.

Our congregation is in a period of transition, and as we navigate transition together, we need to be able to hear from each other about what we love about our church and how we envision our future together. It can be easy to avoid conversation about challenging topics because we do not like conflict. But by avoiding these conversations we miss opportunities to learn from each other and can fail to recognize what we have in common, which is a commitment to our faith and to the future of St. Peter's.

The first event will be an introduction to the work of Braver Angels. Titled "Crossing the Continental Divide," it will be held Sunday February 25 from 9:15-10:15am in the Family Life Center and will be led by Linda Beck, ambassador for the Lower Susquehanna Alliance of Braver Angels. The follow-up workshop will be held on Saturday, April 13 from 9am-12pm in the Family Life Center. The workshop is "Depolarizing Within," and will be facilitated by Nita Landis and Melissa Gizzi, co-chairs of the Lower Susquehanna Alliance. The Braver Angels facilitators have a great deal of experience working with community organizations and congregations, and we are eager to bring their expertise to St. Peter's.

We encourage you to mark your calendars and make it a priority to participate in these events.


