The impressive turnout to this event demonstrates just how many people at St. Peter's care about the problem of divisions in our communities and want to do something about it. We are grateful to Braver Angels for being willing to give away their expertise and lead us toward building stronger relationships in our congregation and beyond.

Some members who attended definitely left wanting more, and the good news is that **registration is now open for the "Depolarizing Within" workshop on Saturday, April 13 from 9 a.m.-noon.** This free event is run by the co-chairs of the Lower Susquehanna Alliance of Braver Angels specifically for members of St. Peter's.
