Quilters News Update



The St. Peter's quilting group recently ended their work sessions for the summer. We wanted to give everyone an idea of what we have accomplished since September, 2023 until May, 2024. We completed 129 quilts which were donated to various non-profit groups in our local community. Below is a thank you note we received from Gaudenzia for the 45 quilts we donated to two of their programs.

On behalf of Gaudenzia's Centro Primavera and Vantage programs, I wanted to say "Thank YOU" for the lovely quilts given to us. They are so wonderful and colorful. They will provide warmth and comfort to all that receive them.

Centro Primavera's two summer programs start in a few weeks. We have one program for 5-12 year olds and another for 13-18 year olds. Centro Primavera is located in North Philadelphia and is specifically for students that are high risk for Substance Use Disorder due to family use/exposure to drugs and alcohol and other traumas. We are very excited to have the quilts for the students to use if they need a "hug". They will be able to utilize their blankets and at the end of the summer program they will take them home with them as a wonderful memory of their time spent with us.

Vantage has 3 families that are moving out in the near future and these quilts will be helpful as they move into their own apartments, a halfway house, or other housing.
